

AMBEDKAR UNIVERSITY, DELHI, SCHOOL OF UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES:  
Promotion of students from Semester II to Semester III of programme.

**The policy for promotion of undergraduate students from Semester 2 to Semester 3 of their programmes is as follows (as per recommendation of the Evaluation Committee of the School on 17 March 2011):**

- Students must obtain grades of C+ (C Plus) or higher in courses of Semesters 1 and 2 amounting to 24 credits (i.e., 6 courses) in order to proceed to Semester 3. Students who by the commencement of the academic year 2011-12 have not completed the 24 credits shall *not* enroll in Semester 3. They may be directed to repeat courses of the first programme year as directed by the Evaluation Committee of the School.
- Students with course grades of lower than C+ in the first programme year could be directed toward 'partial repetition' of as many as two failed courses (of 8 credits) over the summer (i.e., late May - July). The SUS Evaluation Committee shall decide which failed course(s) a student must improve through partial repetition and which course(s) must be entirely repeated in the following year. A student earning passing grades through partial repetition, and achieving the required total of 24 (or more) credits for the first programme year, could be permitted to enroll in courses of Semester 3.
- Although they may proceed from Semester 2 to Semester 3 with a grade average of less than B – (B Minus), *students in SUS are required to achieve an **overall** programme grade of B – (B Minus).*
